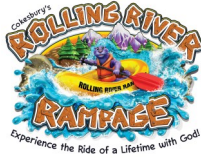

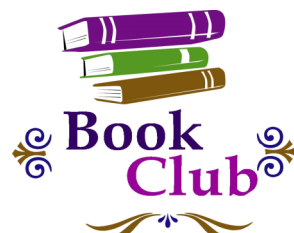


New Habitat for Humanity Build has Started!
