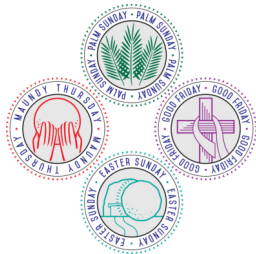

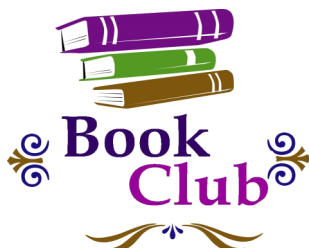
500 years ago the Reformation began with a renewed focus on the basics of the Christian faith. We explore those basics and what they mean for us today. This class is led by one of our pastors.
