Sunday School is available at 9:45 a.m. for children age 2 through grade 12.

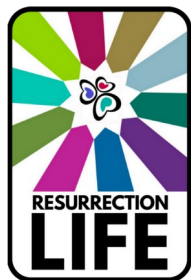
Grades 9-12 meet in the Youth Pavilion.

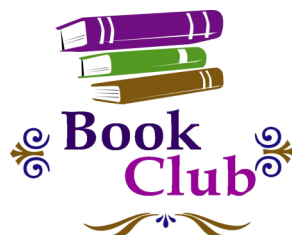


New Habitat for Humanity Build
