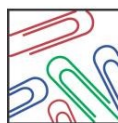

## Color Me Lent

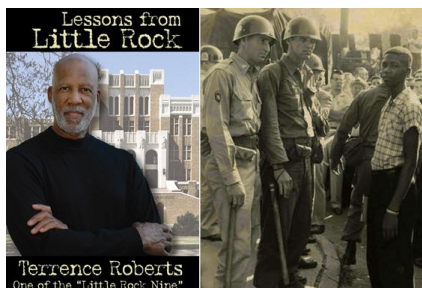
