Sunday School Needs YOU!

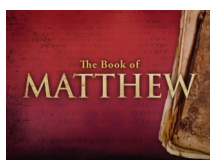

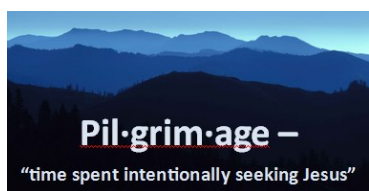
The Book of Matthew Sunday School Study at 11 a.m. beginning Aug. 6
