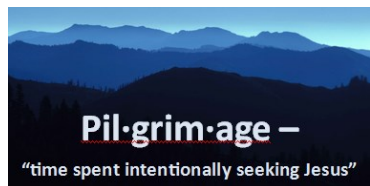


The Church in Society: A Lutheran Perspective
