"Frolic" Bibles & Children Bulletins

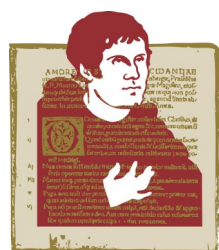

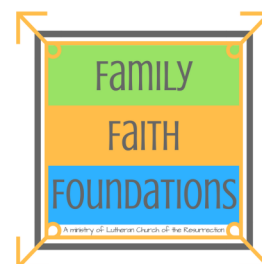


Male Chaperone Needed
