



LCR Inclement Weather Policy

In the event of severe weather, such as snow or ice, or other emergency, the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection will determine the status of church programs and communicate it as expeditiously as possible.

LCR will announce the status of daytime operations no later than 8:00 a.m. of the current and by 4:00 p.m. for evening activities of the current day. Unfortunately, circumstances may cause this goal not to be met. We appreciate your understanding in these situations.

Overall, we will adhere to the following guidelines:

- If at all possible, weddings, funerals and other major one-time special events will be conducted as scheduled.
- Weekday program activities will follow the schedule of Cobb County Government Offices. If Cobb County Government Offices are delayed in the morning, the opening of the church office will be delayed and all program activities will be delayed (or cancelled depending on the length of the delay). If the Cobb County Government Offices close early, the church office will close early and all evening programs will be cancelled.
- The church office will be closed and all activities will be cancelled if the Cobb County Government Offices are closed.

In the event of a closing or delayed opening due to inclement weather or other emergency, an announcement will be:

- Placed prominently on the church website
- Emailed to members via the church e-news distribution.
