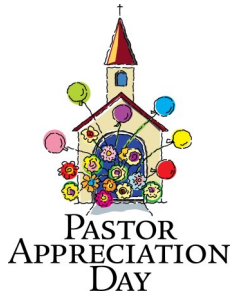

Prayer Leader / Assisting Minister Training **TODAY** and Oct. 14 after each service

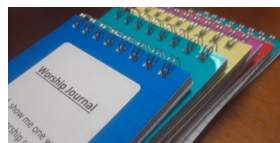
