If you are a current communion minister or if you are interested in becoming a communion minister, stay for 15 minutes after each service for a quick training.

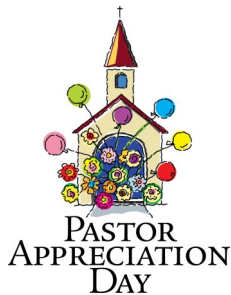
