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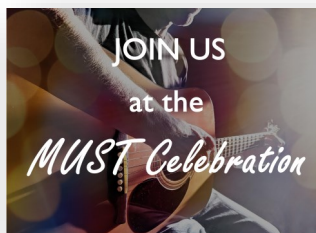

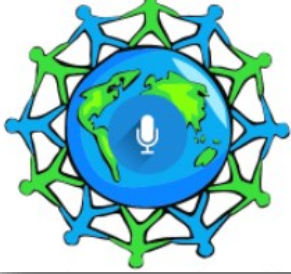

Synod Assembly

Hello LCR members and friends,
We would like to thank you and the Church Council for sending us to the 2022 Southeastern Synod Assembly in Chattanooga as voting delegate members on June 3rd – 5th.

The Assembly theme was “Unmute Yourself,” which was an appropriate theme for the first Synod Assembly since the pandemic, and over two years of people gathering together via Zoom. This theme was woven throughout the three-day assembly, where numerous people “unmuted” themselves to share their faith stories.

The Assembly was very educational, and we learned a lot about the greater church. The Synod does a lot more than we ever thought they did! Some areas that stood out are the Synod’s work with Youth, including SESLYO (The Southeastern Synod Lutheran Youth Organization), as well as work for Diversity & Justice and Disaster Relief Work. The Assembly also included approval of the Synod’s financial budget, as well as electing officers and At-Large Synod Council members, and votes on Resolutions and Memorials that were brought forward. 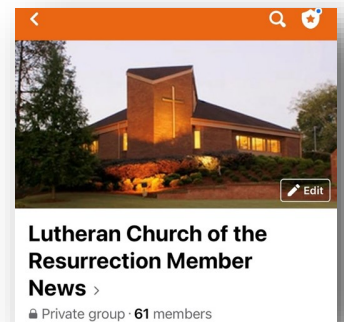

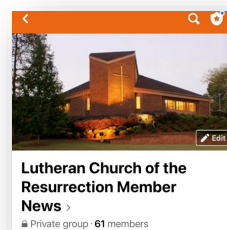
