As you may be aware, Cobb County was raised to the High Risk for Covid Transmission level last week. This is of particular concern with the new information that people are being re-infected with Covid even though they were recently sick and were thought to have immunity. The CDC recommendation at this level is to mask indoors due to the high community risk.

In keeping with the desire to protect our most vulnerable members as well as the emergence of the new BA.5 variant, the Church Council strongly encourages everyone at worship, both attendees and those serving, to **voluntarily** wear masks until Cobb County's transmission level has dropped.

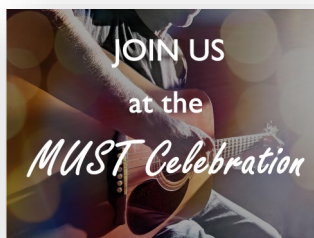
CHRISTMAS IN JULY Supporting Special Needs Cobb July 10 – 31

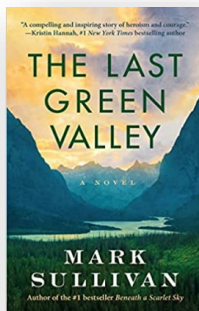

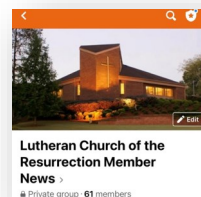
