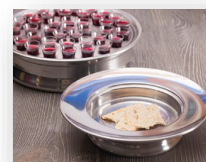
Altar Flowers—Increase in Cost

The cost of land, lumber and other materials and skilled labor such as electricians are all going up dramatically. Hosting a successful fundraiser this year is critical.

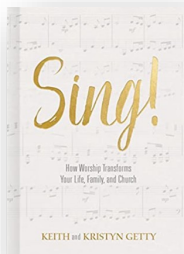
