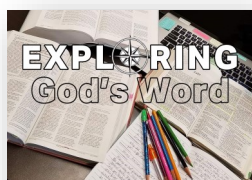
If you have not registered your child/children for Sunday school, please take a moment and use the link to the right to do so.

Altar Flowers—Increase in Cost

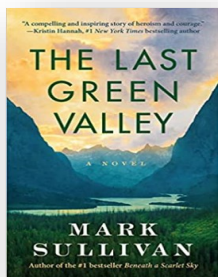
