If you emailed Sigrid to make a name tag, those have been added to the "Name Tag Tree."

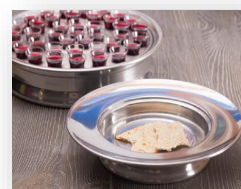


LCR Fellowship

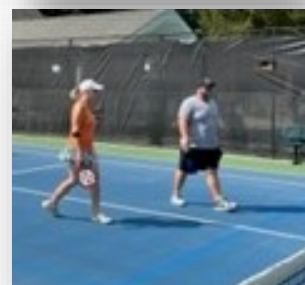

Grace House Food Collection Thru October 23

Thank you to everyone who has started to bring in non-perishable food items for Grace House, the Lutheran and Episcopal Campus Ministry located on the campus of Georgia Tech. The food ministry has become one important resource at Grace House, because even at Georgia Tech, 1 in 5 students skip a meal a week due to a lack of food. The food pantry has been available 24/7 since March 2020, and thanks to a lot of incredible volunteer donations, the food pantry has stocked with non-perishable items.

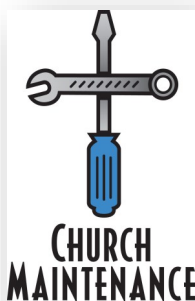


Pastor Dave's Retirement Party October 29 from 4—7 pm
