- Watch for a new **video** to be posted on Friday. It will emphasize why congregational participation in the Appreciative Interview Process is important and review the steps in the call process.

- All interviewers are invited to a **briefing** on Saturday, January 21, at 11:00 am. Bring any questions, so you are confident and ready to begin.
- Please sign up to be **interviewed**. You can do so via [Sign-up Genius](#) or you can sign up in person at church this Sunday and next. Look for the people with clip boards.
- We are looking to use the best features of LCR to shape, with God's help, LCR's future—and to determine what kind of pastor can lead us into that future. Here are the interview questions so you can think about them in advance and come prepared with helpful answers.

1. Remembering your entire experience at LCR, when were you the most alive, most motivated, and most excited about your involvement? When did your faith deepen? When did your relationships with others grow stronger? What made it this way?

2. What do you value most about LCR? What activities or ingredients or ways of life are most important? What are the best features of this church?

3. Make three wishes for the future of LCR. What would the congregation look like when they are made real?

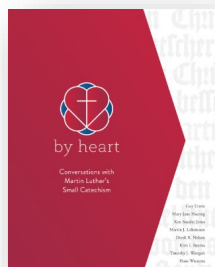

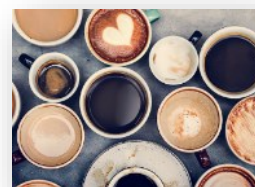

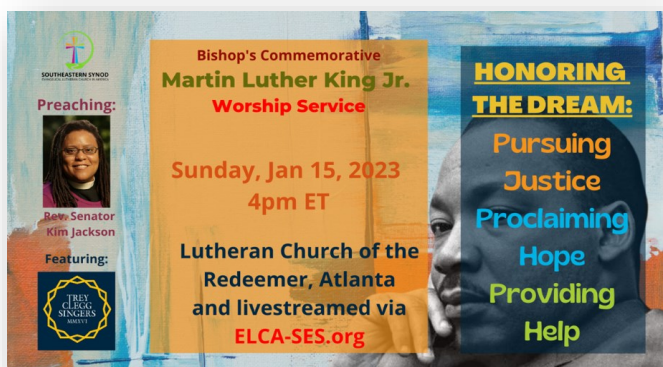
