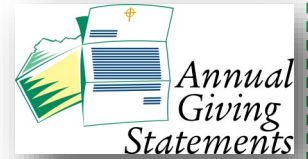

Then we will compile and organize the responses and report the summary results to you.

1. Remembering your entire experience at LCR, when were you the most alive, most motivated, and most excited about your involvement? When did your faith deepen? When did your relationships with others grow stronger? What made it this way?

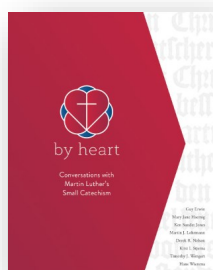
