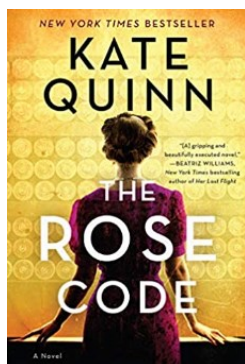
Lenten Collection

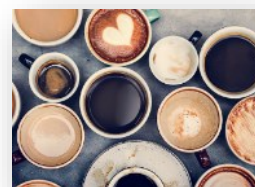

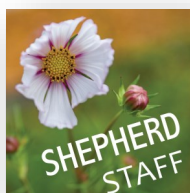


2023 Altar Flowers

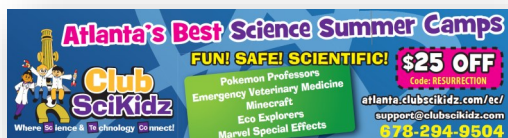
