**Don't miss this fun event! There will be something for everyone, including:**

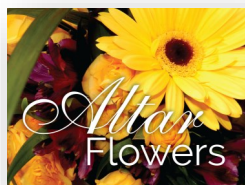
- ⇒ Food trucks serving breakfast and lunch, a Waffle House bar, and Refuge Coffee truck
