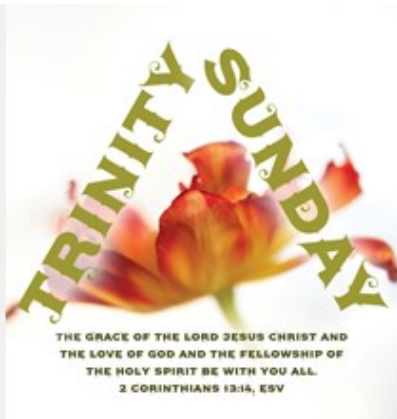

Holy Trinity Sunday

This Sunday we celebrate the Holy Trinity—one God in three persons. Paul writes in the book of Romans that through Jesus we have peace with God [the Father], whose love pours into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, giving us lasting hope.



The observance of a day in honor of the Holy Trinity came out of the controversies in the fourth and fifth centuries over the nature of Jesus. It was finally set in the church calendar in the year 1334.

Holy Trinity Sunday, while not a commemoration of a historical event, is a celebration of the experience of God in the Bible; simply a celebration of the mystery of God. Falling the Sunday after Pentecost, it is the culmination of the three great festivals of the church: Christmas, Easter and Pentecost.

One of the most enduring traditional hymns, “Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty,” borrows its imagery from chapters 4 and 5 of the book of Revelation; to give us in vivid language the glory of God the blessed Trinity.

Each time we gather to worship, we begin and end with a confession of the Trinity. Join us this Sunday as we celebrate the Holy Trinity!

This Sunday in church we are going to talk about “**The Holy Trinity**” from John 16:12-15. The Bible teaches us that God is three unique persons, yet he is ONE GOD. He is God the FATHER, God the SON (JESUS), and God the HOLY SPIRIT. We call this the *trinity or triune nature of God*, because trinity or triune means having three parts. 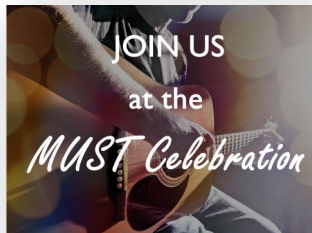

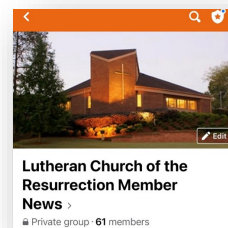
