Hello LCR members & friends,

Your council recently held our May meeting, and consistent with what I reported in the Town Hall and Annual Meeting, LCR is in a very strong financial position. We continue to project a financial surplus for the fiscal year ending May 2022, and as such, are headed into our new fiscal year financially sound.

We are blessed to be able to support others, and your council approved the Endowment team's recommendation of a \$3,448 donation to Lutheran World Relief. This brings the LCR Endowment fund's total disbursements for the fiscal year ending May 2022 to just over \$38,000. This is a great example of one way LCR is living out our vision and mission in the world.

I would also like to congratulate Catherine Strate on her election as the next LCR Church Council president, effective June 1st. She is a deeply faithful disciple of Christ, has been heavily involved in the life of LCR, and has excellent leadership skills for this role. I wish Catherine the best of luck.

Lastly, I would like to thank all of you for your support over the past four years I have been Church Council president. LCR is a special place, and it has been an honor to lead LCR forward during this time. Thank you.

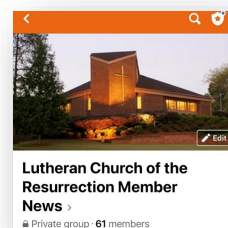
