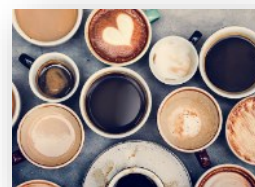

The 39th annual Hunger Walk/Run is coming up in a little over 2 weeks on Sunday, March 12th. We have raised \$1,700 and have about a dozen

walkers. If you have not had a chance to support this long-time Outreach effort of LCR, join your co-chairs Stephen Goodnough, Rachel Thornton, and Mike Frey for this fun family outing with a purpose by signing up this Sunday outside the Sanctuary to walk or make a donation into one of Shaq's oversized tennis shoes. Last year we raised over \$7,000 and had over 30 walkers. You may also sign-up online on our Hunger Walk Team Page [here](#).

As we have the last few years, we are offering a local walk at LCR from the church parking lot. You can also go to downtown Atlanta and join others from around the state in a 5K walk which starts at 2:00 pm. The LCR event will start with lunch at 12:15 pm, and the walk will start about 1:00 pm. The walk is about a 1 mile loop on Robin Rd and Sherwood Rd. You can walk it as many times as you like. We will also have live music before and after the walk.

Please remember that 24% of the funds raised comes back to LCR for our Outreach ministries, in addition to 36% going to Inspiritus for their basic needs programs, and 40% goes to the Atlanta Community Food Bank for their food programs. The needs are great in Cobb County and the metro-Atlanta area and you can make a difference!

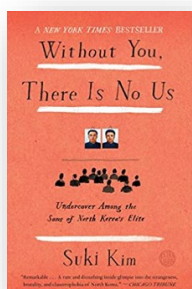

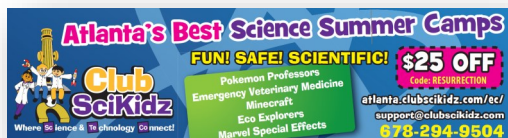
