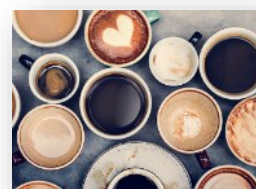

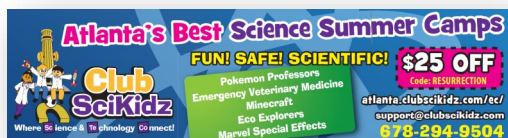


2023 Christian Response Campaign
