## **CAC Food Drive Ending**

Sunday is the last day to bring donations for the Community Assistance Center (CAC) Food Drive to the Gathering Room.

This year we are collecting less perishable fresh produce as well as canned and boxed food.

#### **Less Perishable Fresh Items:**

sweet potatoes, red potatoes, white potatoes, beets, winter (acorn) squash, butternut squash, bulb onions, and apples

#### **Boxed and Canned Foods:**

canned fruit, canned meats, canned vegetables, cereal, oatmeal, dried beans, macaroni & cheese, canned chili, canned beef stew, dry pasta, rice, peanut butter, and tomato sauce

In just the first week of our drive we brought 297 lbs. of canned/boxed food and 97 lbs. of less perishable fresh food to the CAC Food Pantry!

## Grace House: Embracing a Labyrinth Journey

At Grace House, our commitment to transforming the campus and the world goes beyond simply offering a welcoming environment for students. We nurture the spiritual journey of our students. We invite them into worship on Mondays and Tuesdays and during small groups on Thursdays.

In our evening worship sessions, we experience the power of singing and prayers. We engage in thoughtprovoking sermons and discussions that spark reflection. And we share communion together.

One thing that makes our worship unique is our invitation to students to explore worship in ways that may be new to them. We encourage them to integrate worship into their daily lives, extending its impact beyond the walls of Grace House.
