Greetings LCR community! January is already proving to be an exciting month of activity and moving forward to enhance LCR's mission and ministries both within the congregation and in the East Cobb community.

Within the LCR community, steps have been taken to re-initiate the Greeters ministry before each of the services to welcome all to worship. John and Miriam Whetstone, who were previously involved with the Greeters ministry, have volunteered to lead the effort, coordinate the scheduling as well as train those who are interested in serving as Greeters.

The annual Christian Response campaign was kicked off on Sunday and will run through March 3rd. With the theme of "Come Fly With Us," the LCR community will be able to continue to soar in its positive engagement in its many programs and efforts through financial giving and the support of volunteer talents of its members and friends. Under the leadership of Rich Rydarowski, the community will be hearing more about this critical campaign throughout the next five weeks.

In response to the Appreciative Inquiry surveys, Council has been actively discussing and researching various methods to increase LCR's presence and visibility in the East Cobb and surrounding communities, that will result in families visiting and hopefully joining the LCR community. At the January meeting, Council voted on replacing our current sign with an electronic sign that will give us more flexibility to share what is happening at LCR, be easier, safer, and quicker to add or change information, enhance LCR's appearance, and make LCR more physically visible to the public. It is anticipated that it will be installed within the next two to three months.

And finally, we are all looking forward to Pastor Rich joining us this week and beginning his time with us.
