





Final Lenten Dinner and Speaker Series plus Worship

The Palm Sunday liturgy includes a semi-dramatized reading of the Passion narrative from the Gospel of Mark, with familiar hymns and a music offering by LCR's handbell ensemble, Resurrection Bells.

On Good Friday, we commemorate the death of Christ on the cross. At noon we will hear the Passion narrative from the Gospel of John, with veneration of the cross. Join us at 7:00 PM for a special Tenebrae service, where we will hear the Passion narrative as the lights in the church go out. Tenebrae is traditionally concluded by a loud noise called the strepitus, which recalls the earthquake at the moment of Christ's death.
