Below are some updates on initiatives and upcoming events:

- The 2024 Annual Meeting will be held on Sunday, May 5 at 12:30 in the Sanctuary. Information for the Annual Report is currently being gathered from LCR Leadership. The Town Hall meeting is scheduled on Wednesday, May 1 at 6:30 in the Gathering Room.
- One of the most important components of the Annual Meeting is the
  presentation of the 2024-2025 budget. In order for the Finance Team to
  develop a viable budget, it is essential to have a strong understanding of
  the congregation's financial commitment. If you have not submitted your
  commitment as of yet, please send the card or drop it off in the Church
  Office addressed to the Financial Secretary or submit your commitment
  via our website. A commitment in any amount is important in supporting
  LCR's ministries.
- Cobb County has approved the permit for LCR to reface the existing sign
  with a new Electronic Messaging Center. LCR has entered into a contract
  with United Sign Company, and we are happy to share that two
  anonymous donors have contributed approximately two-thirds of the cost
  of the sign. We sincerely appreciate David Meszaros's efforts with this
  project.
- The Facilities Management team installed two surveillance cameras to increase security on the LCR campus. There have been reports of unplanned gatherings on the property and we want to assure the safety of the LCR property and our congregation. Thanks to Charles Demosthenes and David Price for installing the cameras.
